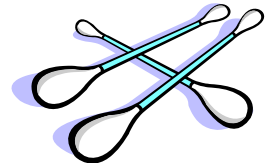

CONGRATULATIONS OFFICER SHAVER

Officer Jeff Shaver was recognized on Wednesday, November 18, 2009 at the Northern VA Criminal Justice Academy for his success in the 2009 Smooth Operator Campaign. Each year, from May to September, law enforcement agencies in Virginia have four one-week waves to concentrate efforts on problematic traffic violations. At the end of the waves the officer who issues the most summonses or warnings is recognized at an awards ceremony. The campaign was created to give law enforcement an opportunity to focus on selective enforcement for specific problematic areas of traffic laws such as Aggressive Driving, DUI, Seat belt usage for adults, and safety seats for children. This is the second year in a row that Officer Shaver has been the recipient of this award for Haymarket Police Department. Congratulations Officer Shaver.

TOWN GOVERNMENT UPDATES

As we can all see the Quarles Center project is moving along rapidly. The Town is working closely with CVS and Fauquier Bank regarding their signage. Fauquier Bank is planning their grand opening in January 2010 and CVS should be soon to follow sometime in February.

The Town Council and Planning Commission have spent the past year working on Code revisions. Included in those revisions were significant changes to the sign ordinance. On November 2, 2009 the Town held a public hearing to receive input on the proposed changes. For a complete copy of the text, please contact the Town Clerk at 703-753-2600.

The Town Council gave permission to the Haymarket Regional Food Bank to use the Town Hall offices through the end of the year. See page 3 of this newsletter for additional information regarding the Food Bank.

The Town Council has approved a business license application for Signature Sports & Entertainment, t/a Haymarket Sportsplex, to be located at 6612 James Madison Highway (behind Alibi Catering and Saddlery Liquidators). Though the Town is no longer under contract for the sale of the Town Center Property, the council has reaffirmed their desire to sell the Town Center Property to Haymarket Walking Town Development Group, LLC. Should the Town be presented with a new contract, additional public hearings will be held to receive the public's input regarding the sale. The Town will continue to keep you informed via mailings, the web site, and in the newsletter.

The Town has applied for an energy block grant to retrofit the street lights from metal halide to LED in the Town and to retrofit the windows in the government offices to energy efficient windows. The Town should receive notification sometime in December if these grants are awarded.
