****INCIDENTS****

Possess Marijuana – On July 28 at 12:00 PM, officers stopped a vehicle for speeding in the area of Old Carolina Road and Somerset Crossing. On approach, the officer noticed an odor of marijuana coming from the car. After the driver turned over a smoking device and a subsequent search located small amounts of marijuana, she was charged with possession of marijuana.

DUI, Unreasonably Refuse, Contribute to the Delinquency of a Minor – On July 29 at 11:55 PM, officers stopped a vehicle for speeding in the 15000 block of Washington Street. On approach, the officer detected a strong odor of alcoholic beverage from the driver. After performing a series of standardized field sobriety tests, the driver was arrested for driving under the influence and for unreasonably refusing a breath/blood test. She was also charged with contributing to the delinquency of a minor based on the fact that her 3 yoa daughter was in the vehicle with her. Subsequent to the arrest, the daughter was turned over to her father.
