**Possess Marijuana** – On July 5 at 5:55 PM, officers stopped a vehicle in the area of Old Carolina Road and Haymarket Drive for a traffic violation. After the officer noticed a strong odor of marijuana, the operator admitted to recently smoking and possessing and was subsequently charged and released on a summons.

**Contributing to the Delinquency of a Minor (three counts), Drunk in Public** – On July 5 at 12:19 AM, officers responded to the Sheetz for a report of a suspicious person. On arrival, the officer located the suspect and determined that he was intoxicated and had walked to Sheetz in an effort to be arrested because he had a problem with alcohol. The officer also determined that the suspect had left his three children, ages 8, 7, and 8 months old, at home alone. The officer responded to the residence and both had the mother return home from work and checked on the status of the children. Once it was determined that the children were safe, the suspect was arrested for one count of drunk in public and three counts of contributing.

**Possess Marijuana** – On July 9 at 11:15 AM, officers stopped a vehicle on Washington Street for speeding. On approach to the vehicle, the officer detected a strong odor of marijuana and after a search, the operator was charged with possession of marijuana and released on a summons.
