Dear Mr. Vanderpool and Mr. Crim:

Upon review of the Notice of Veto of Resolutions/Ordinances issued by Mayor Leake on June 30, 2014, regarding the Town Council's adoption of the 2015 annual operating budget as well as the draft minutes and tapes of Haymarket Town Council meetings of June 23, 2014 and June 27, 2014, it is clear that the Town of Haymarket is currently operating without an adopted budget in violation of Title 15.2 Chapter 25 of the Code of Virginia.

It is clear from the record that the Town Council erroneously adopted the budget text at the June 23, 2014 meeting. As a result, Councilman Tobias, as a member of the prevailing side of the vote, properly motioned to reconsider the vote of June 23, 2014 adopting the Fiscal Year 2015 Budget. Said motion was adopted unanimously. As a result of accepted Parliamentary Procedure, at that point in time the original motion regarding the FY 2015 Budget made on June 23, 2014 was placed before the Town Council as if it had not been previously voted on, effectively nullifying it existence. Subsequent to the motion to reconsider the Town Council unanimously adopted a meaningless resolution to rescind the vote of June 23, 2014, meaningless as the adopted vote to reconsider had already rendered the vote null and void. Subsequently, the Town Council adopted an amended FY 2015 Budget.

Although Mayor Leake seemingly has the power to veto (notwithstanding the provisions of 15.2-1423) those votes listed in his veto of June 30, 2014, he does not have the power to veto the motion to reconsider, a motion the record also indicates he did not attempt to veto. As a result, as of the adjournment of the June 27, 2014 meeting of the Haymarket Town Council the only existent FY 2015 Budget was that adopted on the evening of June 27, 2014 (resolution 20140627-4). As Mayor Leake vetoed said resolution on June 30, 2014 and the Haymarket Town Council did not override the veto at its worksession of July 1, 2014, the Town of Haymarket is effectively operating without an adopted FY 2015 Annual Budget and thus can not allocate funds for salaries and expenses incurred during FY 2015.

Given those circumstances and the joint public hearing scheduled to be held by the Planning Commission and the Town Council this evening, July 7, 2014, I will require a determination as to the impact of the Town of Haymarket operating without an adopted budget on the actions and salary of the Planning Commission prior to this evening's Planning Commission meeting being called to order.




