PUBLIC HEARING

MARCH 5, 1990

The Public Hearing to amend the Zoning Ordinance reference to Site Plans and other minor updates was called to order at 7:30 p.m. on March 5, 1990.

It had been advertised two times in the Journal Messenger, on Thursday Feb. 15, 1990 and on Thursday February 22, 1990.

PRESENT:

All Council Members were present with the exception of Sam Crouch. Also Present were Mayor Terri R. Freeborn, Lorene Payne, Attorney Turner T. Smith and a group of Business Men from the Town.

LORENE PAYNE:

Lorene Payne went over the proposed amendments and explained all of them.

FOR:

Lyssa Whitfield spoke in favor of them.

AGAINST:

No one actually spoke against them.

SPEAKERS:

Dr. Weaver asked the Mayor what her understanding about alterations were, these were explained by Lorene Payne. Dr. Weaver also mentioned he would like a month or so to look the amendments over. Attorney Steve Woodside also said he would like time to look them over. Turner Smith suggested receiving written reports on the amendments for a week. Written reports were to be received until the close of business on March 12, 1990.

LORENE PAYNE:

Lorene Payne mentioned that the Town Council is the Zoning Administrator. If there is a violation, the Building Inspector would meet with Council and the person in violation will also be invited by the Town Council to come in.

MR. BEAR:

A question asked by Glenwood Bear was, if Council doesn't have an answer on site plans, would they then go to the Board of Zoning Appeals to which Lorene Payne answered yes if it was an administrator's task and not a legislative task.

ADJOURNMENT:

The Public Hearing adjourned at 8:05 p.m. with Mayor Freeborn saying action on the amendments would be delayed at least for one week to receive written comments.
