REGULAR SESSION:

AT 6:45 p.m. Hancock made a motion to go back into Regular Session, seconded by Bean, the motion carried.

IN REGULAR SESSION:

In Regular Session,, James Shepard made a motion to hire Thomas Kiley as Police Officer for the Town of Haymarket, seconded by Steven Bean, the motion carried unanimously in a Roll Call Vote.

Kiley was told that he was on a 6 months probation and he was to give the schedule of his working hours for the following month by the 2nd Council Meeting each month.

Hancock made a motion to purchase uniforms for Kiley after he checks with uniforms upstairs to see if there is anything he can use, this was seconded by DeCarlo and unanimously approved in a Roll Call Vote.

Kiley mentioned that he is in the National Guard and would need to go for Training Period from June 15-29,1991

Kapp advised Kiley to keep good records and to go over General Orders and Town Codes.

Hancock made a motion that the Town would check on a Vest for Kiley and he was to use the gun the Town has, this was seconded by DeCarlo, the motion carried.
