Town of Haymarket Decal

Decals can be purchased at town hall for a \$15.00 fee and you will need to bring your vehicle registration and ID at the time of purchase. Failure to obtain a decal for your vehicle may result in a citation of \$35.00 in addition to the \$15.00 decal fee.

Decals for Police, Fire, Rescue and Military personnel with proof of employment will be waived.

The 8th Annual Officer Down Memorial Ride on April 27 at 9 AM - 4 PM at the QBE Foundation, 14604 Washington Street. The mission of the ODMR is to honor fallen law enforcement officers and raise awareness of line of duty deaths. The event brings together hundreds of law enforcement motorcycle enthusiasts and supporters from around the country. The ride follows a scenic 60-mile circuit through the foothills of Virginia's Blue Ridge Mountains and culminates in Haymarket for a full day of music, food, police motor demonstrations, and various vendor offerings.

Over the last eight years, they have raised over \$100,000 to support ODMR's mission.

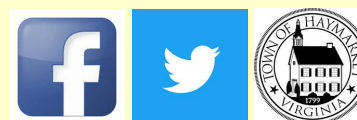

Town of Haymarket - 2019 Calendar

The Town 2019 Desktop Calendar was mailed out by the town to all intown residents. It was complete with important meeting and event dates, as well as some of our favorite photos of our town. Haymarket Town Center



The Mayor and Town Council continue to explore the renovation of the Haymarket Town Center. The project originally incorporated an addition to the rear of the Town Hall, a second story elevator and substantial interior changes. After considering the financial impact of that scope of work, the plans were scaled back. The scope of work is now limited to the exterior of the existing building footprint, with minor interior changes. The façade and roof changes as depicted in this rendering remain the focus of the work. This plan uses current entrance to the Police Department as the main entrance to the building to provide access to the Police Department, Administrative Offices and Council Chambers. The entrance hallway and public restrooms will be upgraded to comply with current ADA requirements and provide space for ingress and egress into the Administrative Offices and Council meeting space. The Town issued invitations for bids on the work in September of 2018. At that time only one bid was received. The project was re-bid in January 2019. At that time the project generated more interest and four bids were received on March 15th. The bids are currently being reviewed along with funding options for the Council's consideration. It is the desire of the Mayor and Council to provide a Town Center Haymarket Residents will be proud of, while remaining compatible with the Town's character.

Playground at the Haymarket Park Planned

This summer the Town of Haymarket will be finalizing plans for the Haymarket Community Park Playground. The Town plans to build out the playground in mid to late summer with a grand opening in late August. The Playground will be open to all community residents daily, and will close at sunset each day.

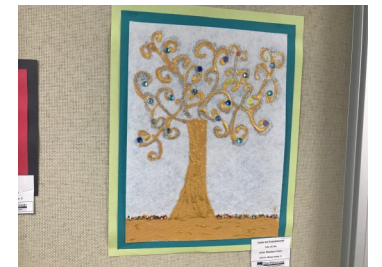

2019 Business License Renewals

BUSINESS LICENSE APPLICATION 2019

The applications for the 2019 Business License have been mailed out. Businesses will need to renew their Town Business Licenses by **April 30, 2019**. Applications can be found on the Town Website, www.townofhaymarket.org, under the Finance pull down menu and Business Licenses.

How to get your garden ready for Spring?

1. Pull up old and dead or dying flowers and plants. Put them in the compost pile or dig them back into the soil. If you have perennials in your flower bed, trim them back. For a new bed, add nutrients. An existing bed that has been fertilized during the season does not need added nutrients.
2. Dig up and turn the soil to a depth of 3 to 4 inches to thoroughly aerate the soil. Use a tiller for a large area or spade and garden fork for a raised bed or smaller area. Take out rocks, roots and sticks. Dig and lift the soil near your perennials. Rake the soil smooth.
3. Cover the bed with new mulch. If your flower bed is going dormant for the winter, you can use plastic sheeting or other inorganic material. If you have planted bulbs or have perennials still growing, add organic mulch to a depth of 2 to 3 inches. Keep mulch at least 3 to 4 inches away from the bottom of existing plants.

Now that your flower bed has been cleaned, fed, aerated and mulched, it is ready for spring planting.
