Town History- Hulfish House

The Hulfish House was built in 1873 by George A. Hulfish, one of the most prominent and successful citizens in Haymarket during the post-Civil War years.

George was a retail merchant, served as the first mayor of the Town after it was incorporated in 1882, and was a trustee of the Town Hall and school (now known as the Haymarket Museum) His story is particularly compelling because he was 15 years old and living in Haymarket when the town was burned in 1862. In fact, it was his father's house and blacksmith shop that were the first buildings set ablaze by members of the Union patrol. The Hulfish House is a vital part of Haymarket's historic landscape especially that of the historic "crossroads" of Old Carolina Road (Jefferson Street), and Washington Street.

The structure is currently home to Cupcake Heaven! So stop in and grab a treat while visiting one of our old, historic structures.
