STAFF REPORT June 26, 2023

FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 BUDGET AMENDMENT

ISSUE

Virginia Code § 15.2-2507 allows a locality to amend its budget and adjust the aggregate amount to be appropriated during the current fiscal year. However, any amendment which exceeds one percent of the total expenditures shown in the currently adopted budget must be accomplished by advertising a meeting and holding a public hearing prior to acting on the amendment. Since each requested amendment does not exceed that amount, a Public Hearing is not required. The Council may adopt the amendment at this meeting.

REQUESTED BUDGET AMENDMENT

1. The requested amendment to the adopted budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 is to amend the Police Department overages by amending existing line items that have been budgeted that will end the year with available funds, due to the anticipated expenditures ending the year lower than predicted when the FY2023 budget was adopted last year.

FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 BUDGET AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, The Haymarket Town Council did adopted the Fiscal Year 2023 Budget on June 21, 2022, and

WHEREAS, The proposed budget amendment will increase line item Development Revenue - Proffers by \$2,551; and

WHEREAS, The proposed budget amendment will increase expenditure line item 1211030 – Capital Outlay – Machinery / Equipment by \$2,551; and

WHEREAS, The proposed budget amendment will decrease expenditure line item 3110001 – Wages & Salaries - Regular by \$10,000; and

WHEREAS, The proposed budget amendment will increase expenditure line item - 3110003 – Salaries & Wages – OT Premium by \$4,500; and

WHEREAS, The proposed budget amendment will increase expenditure line item - 3110005 – Salaries & Wages – Part Time by \$11,000; and

WHEREAS, The proposed budget amendment will increase expenditure line item - 3110021 - VRS by \$2,000; and

WHEREAS, The proposed budget amendment will decrease expenditure line item - 3110022 - Health Insurance by \$4,064; and

WHEREAS, The proposed budget amendment will decrease expenditure line item - 3110042 - Vehicle Fuels by \$8,955; and

WHEREAS, The proposed budget amendment will increase expenditure line item - 3110043 - Vehicle Maintenance/Supplies by \$3,000; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Haymarket Town Council amends the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget as reflected below:

Re: Architectural Review Board and Planning Commission vacancy applications

Background:

The Architectural Review Board had 2 members let their terms expire as of June 30, 2023. Architectural Review Board terms are 4 year terms. Attached are two applications for those vacancies from Joanna Mason and Chuck Mason. The Mason's have shown an interest in serving the Town. Mr. Mason was once on the Planning Commission. Mrs. Mason has shown interest in other areas of the Town. They have been attending recent ARB meetings and. The transition of Mr. and Mrs. Mason would be smooth since they are familiar with the applications at hand. These terms will be effective July 1, 2023 and expiring June 30, 2027.

The Planning Commission terms are also 4 year terms. However, the Planning Commission has had some shifting of terms in the past few months. Previous Council Member Bob Weir was elected to the Board of Supervisors in February 2023. He was the Town Council liaison for the Planning Commission. During this time, Alexander Beyene was serving a term as the Chairman of the Planning Commission. The Council appointed Mr. Beyene to the Town Council and also appointed him as the Town Council liaison taking Mr. Weir's spot which will extend Mr. Beyene's term to December 31, 2024 if elected by special election. This leaves Mr. Beyene's original term vacant. His term will expire June 30, 2024. Attached are three (3) applications for the vacancy: Madhu Panthi, Ed Robinson and Pankaj Singla. Mr. Panthi previously served on the Planning Commission. Mr. Robinson, a long time resident of Haymarket, has also served previously on the Planning Commission. Mr. Singla is new to the Town and has experience in Land Use and Planning. This appointment would fill the unexpired term of Alexander Beyene with the term expiring June 30, 2024, which at that time the appointee could be re-appointed for a 4 year term.
