SUBJECT: Approval of Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Tax Rate

Background:

The Finance Committee reviewed the budget in its entirety in their February 20th committee meeting. They provided their recommendations for the FY 2020-2021 Budget at the March 2, 2020 Council Work Session. Town Council has discussed the budget in their March 26th, April 4th, and April 14th meetings.

A Public Hearing on the proposed real property tax rate was properly advertised on March 11, 2020 and held on April 14, 2020.

At the Town Council April 14, 2020 special meeting, Council directed staff to advertise a Public Hearing for the FY 2020-2021 Annual Budget for May 4, 2020. Town residents will be able to provide comments via mail, email, in person, and via ZOOM.

Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic the Council has discussed passing the current draft budget while knowing that if this pandemic continues, amendments may be necessary in June when more information is available.

Town Council is required to adopt tax rates prior to July 1, 2020.

RESOLUTION TO ADOPT TAX RATES AND A FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2020 AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2021

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Haymarket held several meetings since January discussing the FY 2020-2021 budget, taxes, and fees; and

WHEREAS, the real property tax rate was advertised on March 11, 2020 and a public hearing was held on April 14, 2020 to consider the Proposed FY 2020-2021 Tax Rates in accordance with Section 58.1-3321 of the Code of Virginia; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined to keep the Town fee schedule unchanged from the previous Fiscal Year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Haymarket, Virginia meeting in special session this 21st day of April 2020, adopts the tax rates and fee schedule attached to this Resolution in support of the budget.
