

SPECIAL HAYMARKET TOWN COUNCIL MEETINGOCTOBER 6, 1988

The special meeting of the Haymarket Town Council began promptly at 7:30 p.m.

PRESENT:

Present at the meeting were; Mayor Gertrude Bean, Council Members; Terri Freeborn, James R. Gossom, John Kapp, Michael Krebs and also Dorothy Keller, Town Clerk and William Green, Chairman of the Planning Commission. Mr Dennis Mackey, General Manager of Cablevision of Manassas was also present.

PURPOSE:

The Purpose of the Special meeting was to take another vote from Council as to whether to approve or disapprove the Tower Cablevision wants to put up on Century Stairs property, at 15151 Washington Street. It was previously approved at the September 19, 1988 Haymarket Town Council meeting but as Councilman Michael Krebs requested permission to withdraw his vote because of a possible conflict of interest since he is employed by Century Stairs, the motion needed to be repeated.

DISCUSSION:

During the discussion period Councilwoman Terri Freeborn said that she preferred that the tower not be painted orange and white, that it should be a neutral color to blend in with the environment. Mr. Mackey said the tower would be about 200 feet and would have a light on the top of it. Also it will not be within 200 feet from any building.

MOTION:

John Kapp made a motion to approve the Tower for Cablevision provided it be a galvanized steel color with a beacon on the top as required by F.F.A., this was seconded by James Gossom. In a Roll Call Vote, Freeborn, Gossom and Kapp voted for it, Krebs abstained from voting, therefore the motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT:

With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:42 p.m.
