

SPECIAL MEETING

MAY 20, 1987

A Special Haymarket Town Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Gertrude Bean on May 20, 1987, at 7:30 p.m. The purpose of the meeting was for Council to approve or disapprove two houses to be built at 6661 Fayette St. The applicants for the permits were G.R. Johnston and Michael Heslop (Church Street Associates).

The property is owned by Macon Piercy and Ellen Wilson, co-owners, to be sold to Church Street Associates. On January 20, 1986, Piercy and Wilson requested the Haymarket Town Council to approve a Pipe Stem Plan regarding their property. It was to be divided into two lots and it was referred to the Planning Commission at that time who were to report back on it at the next meeting. The Pipe Stem Plan was approved at the Feb. 17, 1986 meeting of the Haymarket Town Council after being approved by the Haymarket Planning Commission.

At the Special meeting on May 20, 1987, Councilman William Utz made a motion that the Two houses could be built on the Pipe Stem Plan, seconded by Councilman James Gossom and unanimously approved in a Roll Call Vote. With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 7:40 p.m.
