

SPECIAL MEETINGHAYMARKET TOWN COUNCILSEPTEMBER 30, 1985

A special meeting was called to order at 7 p.m. on September 30, 1985 by Mayor Gertrude Bean to discuss Police Business. All Council Members were present and Attorney Peter Steketee.

The Mayor read a letter of resignation from Police Sergeant Donn Fasick to become effective as of Sept. 30, 1985. Councilman Fewell Melton made a motion to accept officer Fasick's resignation, seconded by Councilman Sam Crouch and approved.

Councilman Richard Bird made a motion to advertise in the newspaper once a week for 2 weeks that the Town would be accepting applications until the Oct. 21 Meeting, for a Police Sergeant, this was seconded by Councilman James Gossom and approved. Mr. Bird mentioned that for the present time he will put the Police Cruiser at the Fire Dept. for safety reasons. Mayor Bean was to send a copy of Officer Fasick's resignation to Richmond. Mr. Gossom wanted the insurance on the Police Cruiser cancelled until it was put in use again.

With no further business, Mr. Melton made a motion at 7:45 p.m. to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Bird.
