

A special meeting to decide what to do about painting or putting siding on Town Hall and to look over the estimates began at 8 p.m. on August 28, 1984. Five Council members were present, Mr. Bird was absent.

Minutes of the August meeting were read and approved after one correction was made. Mrs Breen made a statement about the improper trimming of the trees on her property, she did not complain about it.

Mr. Orndoff asked for a roll call vote of Council Members as to whether they wanted to put siding on Town Hall, the vote was unanimous in favor of the siding.

Mr. Green gave several estimates on putting the siding on and recommended that Henricks Roofing and Siding Co, Inc., which is located at 7410 Gallerher Rd., Gainesville, Va. phone number is 754-7328. They will give a five year guarantee on workmanship and a lifetime guarantee on materials. Work is to be completed by Haymarket Day, Sept. 15, 1984. In addition to this Mr. Green also gave several estimates on the painting of the roof and trim work on Town Hall to be completed by Sept. 6, 1984. At this time it is undecided who will get the paint contract.

After a lengthy discussion on all this, Mr. Orndoff suggested that Mr. Smith draw up contracts for both the siding and paint work and have them come into his office to sign them. The specifications of the projects were given to Mr. Smith and the dates they each were to be completed. It was stated that Ray Bowers would be signing for the Hendricks Co.

Mr. Smith told Council that a Performance Bond must be given to the Town for at least half of the cost for these jobs.

John Berger, who has been recommended to be Haymarket's new Building and Electrical Inspector was present at the meeting. Mr. Melton and Mr. Crouch have been asked by the Mayor to discuss the terms with Mr. Berger.

With no further business, the Special Meeting adjourned at 9:44 p.m.
