

MAY 21, 1984

Mayor Muriel Gilbertson called the May 21, 1984 Town Council meeting together promptly at 8 p.m. with a prayer and Pledge of Allegiance. The roll call revealed all Council members to be present with the exception of Sam Crouch. Minutes of the April meeting were read and approved. Treasurer Gertrude Bean reported a balance of \$23, 248.71 in the General Account and \$1,442.15 in Revenue Sharing at the end of April. Mrs Bean also notified Council of a letter she had received from the Insurance Company regarding the renewal of insurance on Town Hall. At the present time the premium is \$153 a year and covers \$48,000 on the building and \$3,000 on the contents in it. Councilwoman Anne Smith made a motion to keep it the same, this was seconded by Councilman James Gossom and unanimously approved. Mrs Bean also mentioned that she had received a bill from Vepco for the installation of the new lights installed in Town several years ago. This was to be checked on since it was the understanding that no fee was to be charged for this.

Mr. Harben of the Gainesville Ruritans appeared before Council concerning a Flea Sale the Ruritans wanted to hold on June 16 at Holladays's Market. Councilwoman Gertrude Bean made a motion to give them permission to hold it, seconded by Mr. Gossom and approved.

Mr. Green stated that a person cannot hold two positions on Council as it is unlawful, referring to Mrs Bean who is Treasurer and also a Council member. Attorney Turner Smith checked on it in the law books and agreed. Mrs Bean wanted time to think over which job she will give up.

Mr. Wrye, Planning Commission Chairman asked Council that the revised schedule of fees be accepted and also two forms be adopted, they were the Application For Rezoning and the Applicant's Affidavit. Councilwoman Crewdson made a motion that this be done, seconded by Miss Smith. Councilman Hugh Orndoff and Mrs Bean voted against it and Mr. Gossom passed, which made it a tie vote. Mrs Gilbertson as Tie Breaker voted in favor of it, therefore the motion carried. Mr. Wrye than suggested that a copy be put on the wall in Town Hall.

Allen Gossom appeared before Council for a friend, Paul Godfrey, who wanted to open up a Carpet Shop in part of the building that formerly was the Tack Shop. It is to be known as Paul Godfrey's Carpet Shop and will open June 1. Mr. Wrye stated that the zoning ordinance on this was all right. Mrs Bean made a motion to approve it, seconded by Mr. James Gossom and approved.

In other items of business; #Mr. Wrye wanted to know why the signs "Children Playing" had not been put up on Jefferson st. Councilman Crouch was not present at the meeting to answer this. #He also inquired about the Library Book Drop. Mrs Gilbertson read a letter from the Library saying that the Library had decided to place a Book Drop at Alvey's Store but the Board of Supervisors has approved financing six Mini Libraries in the future, they will try to place one in Haymarket, if not, the Library will put up a book drop outside of Town Hall. Mr. Gossom suggested using the old Post Office. Mrs Crewdson suggested thinking about it to see what the Council could come up with.

#Mrs Green asked for a map of the Town's limits to be used for the Town Picnic.

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It wa again mentioned that the Town's Ordinances should be compiled, no action was taken on this.

#Mr Wrye told Council that the Dept. of Housing and Urban Development will no longer print copies of the Zoning Ordinance and suggested having Craig Osborn printing 50 copies for the sum of \$254.91 Mrs Crewdson made a motion to have Mr. Osborn do it, seconded by Mr. Gossom and approved.

#Robert Crewdson made some good suggestions about the road near the bridge needing to be checked on, taking some action on the condition of the sidewalks in Town, doing something about the drain ditches, and a "NO Dump" sign was needed near the creek.

Miss Smith informed Council that an inspector would try to check on the non-dunctional sewers in Town.

#Mrs Freeborn askded Council if the Board of Zoning Appeals needed a Secretary at times, if they could hire one.

#Mr. Green spoke on grave yard cars in Town. Allen Gossom was to give a copy of the ordinance regarding this to Mr. Smith to look over. Mr. Green also spoke of the recent accident in front of his house and asked that Chief Fasick be supplied with a camera. The Chief said that he had his own camera he could use if Council would supply the film. Miss Smith made a motion to do this, seconded by Mr. Gossom and approved.

#Mr. Wrye representing the Planning Commission asked Mayor Gilbertson to send applications for Rezoning and the Applicant's Affidavit to both Mr. Bolt and Mr. Reuter so ~~that~~ when they were filled out and returned, a Public Hearing could be held for both Gentlemen. Town Clerk Dorothy Keller will be sending them for Mrs Golbertson as she requested her to do.

With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:25 p.m.
