

All members of Council were present at the July 18, 1983 Haymarket Town Council meeting with the exception of Councilman Crouch. It began at 8:05 p.m. with a prayer and Pledge of Allegiance. Minutes of the June meeting were read and approved. Treasurer Gertrude Bean reported a balance of \$18,965.73 in the General Account and \$1,025.79 in Revenue Sharing at the end of June.

Garnett Johnston appeared before Council to secure building permits to build six homes on two acres of land he owns on Madison St. Attorney Turner Smith reminded him that Haymarket now has a sub-division ordinance that he would have to comply with. His license applications will be held until he does that.

Mayor Gilbertson asked the Town Attorney to explain several issues to the Council. They were; the paying of the Attorney fee and court costs totaling \$72 for Mr. Stuart by the Town; Mr. Smith also went over the letter he had submitted to the Mayor concerning licenses and taxes for trucks on the Paxton property; He will check to find out if the Town can collect new sewerage hook-ups; Mrs Gilbertson said she has had complaints about so many Wholesale Used Car Offices in Town. Attorney Smith told her that it is a legal business but also said perhaps a Gross Revenue Tax should be charged in which the Town would have a share in everything rather than the \$25 Business license.

The Town Attorney also drew up an Ordinance that excessive noise from Mini-Bikes shall be unlawful in Town. Councilwoman Smith made a motion that it be adopted, seconded by Councilman Gossom and unanimously approved.

In Police business, Police Chief Don Fasick has received two applications for employment as police officers. As Haymarket is not hiring any at the present time, they will be put on file. Officer Fasick also gave two estimates of \$71640 and \$475 for the purpose of having some body work and a paint job done on a police cruiser. Since some of the Council members had not seen the Pontiac in some time, it was tabled until the Aug. meeting in a motion made by Councilman Orndoff.

With no further business, the meeting adjourned at 9:05 p.m.
