

A special meeting of the Haymarket Town Council was called to order at 8:00 p.m. on July 25, 1979 by Mayor Gilbertson who opened with the pledge of Allegiance. All Council members were present. The meeting was called to discuss the suspension of Town police officer James Wright. Mr. Melton made a motion to go into Executive Session. Miss Smith seconded and the motion carried.

At 10:20 p.m. Miss Smith made a motion to go back into regular session which was seconded by Mr. Orndoff and carried. Mr. Orndoff made a motion that Mr. Wright be reinstated on probation until the question of hour discrepancies in the two record books has been resolved. Mr. Gosson seconded and Council approved with a unanimous vote. Mr. Jones also will check work sheets more carefully in the future so that the situation does not arise again.

Miss Smith made a motion that a committee be appointed to draw up policies of the police department. Mr. Orndoff seconded and Council carried the motion. Mrs. Gilbertson will appoint a committee of three.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 10:30 p.m.
